## **INSTRUCTION GUIDE** TOILET FLANGE



1	Cut the pipe to the desired height.
2	Dry fit flange into the pipe to check for interference.
3	Apply approved Oatey primer using approved application methods to the flange and the drainpipe.
4	Apply approved Oatey cement using approved application methods to the flange and drainpipe.
5	Push the flange down onto the pipe until it is setting flush with or on top of the finished floor.
6	Secure the flange in place using approved screws and possibly anchors for your application. Screws should pass through the finished floor and be secured into the subfloor.
7	Find the center of the flange and install the Johni-bolts.
