

INSTRUCTION GUIDE

WALL TUBE



1 Measure and cut the wall tube to the desired length. Deburr the tube end.

2 Slide nuts and washers onto the wall tube.

a For brass wall tubes with a flange: Install the washer onto the flange.

b For plastic wall tubes without a flange: Only a washer at the wall connection is needed.



3 Insert the wall tube into the waste connector and hand tighten. If using a 1-1/4 in. wall tube with a 1-1/2 in. waste connector, use a reducing washer to make the transition.

4 Connect the J-bend to the wall tube.

5 Tighten the nuts, being sure not to overtighten.

6 Check for leaks. If leaks occur, tighten another 1/4 turn.
